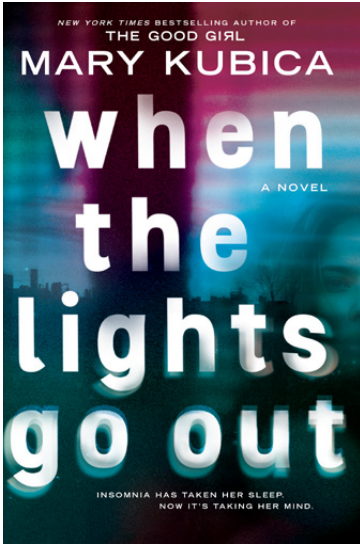

As rumors in town begin to swirl, Samuel wonders whether something more sinister is afoot. Perhaps his mother did not leave after all—perhaps she was murdered...by Ruth.
